

Problems with Privacy Policies


- 1. People don't read privacy policies
- People don't understand privacy policies

Improving on Privacy Policies

- Idea #1: Improve how information is communicated
- Idea #2: Give people choices
- Idea #3: Legally-mandate absolute protections

Privacy consent and choice interfaces

- App permissions interfaces
- Audience controls on social media
- Cookie banners
- Third-party advertising controls
- Marketing opt-outs
- CCPA do not sell my personal information interfaces
- GDPR privacy rights interfaces



California Consumer Privacy Act

- Goal: Give users more control over their personal information.
- Introduced four key rights:
 - The right to know
 - 2. The right to delete
 - 3. The right to opt-out of sale
 - 4. The right to non-discrimination
- Signed: June 28, 2018
- Enforced: July 1, 2020

The Right to Opt-out of Sale

Users have the right to opt-out of the sale of their personal information.


Businesses must provide a "a clear and conspicuous link" on the homepage of their website entitled "Do Not Sell My Personal Information".

How usable are CCPA opt-outs?

- Consumer reports study (May 2021)
- identified 234 California data brokers
- randomly assigned people to opt-out of sale on websites
- 403 participants
- analyzed 3 requests 214 data brokers


How usable are CCPA opt-outs?

a manual observational study



Link Accessibility (Top 500 U.S.)




User Study: Link vs. Banners










CCPA Opt-out Assistant






User Study: Extension


- 54 users recruited on MTurk
- 52 users recruited through Google Ads
- Asked to install and use extension for 1 week
 - 32 MTurkers installed CCPA Opt-out Assistant
 - 22 MTurkers installed control extension
- Logged user behavior
 - hash of website visited
 - whether website had valid (or ambiguous) opt-out of sale link
 - if and how user invoked right to opt-out
- Accepted all participants who used kept extension installed for at least 24 hours




Opt-out Rates











User Experience: Satisfaction



Global Privacy Control (GPC)


- browser signal that indicates desire to opt-out of sale on all websites
- Currently available in Firefox, Brave, DuckDuckGo, etc.
- Also available as a Chrome extension




legally considered a valid signal under CCPA
